Participation Limited to First 300 Registrants!

- When:** Monday, January 16, 2012.
- Where:** Peachtree Presbyterian Church, Family Center, 3434 Roswell Road Northwest, Atlanta, GA 30305-1231
- Open to:** All scholastic players in grades K-12
- Format:** Five rounds, Individual/Team Swiss System. 30 minutes per player per game with 5 second delay.
- Sections:** USCF rated Kindergarten/First (K-1), Primary (K-3), Elementary (K-5), Middle School (6-8), High School (9-12); Non-rated Elementary (K-5), Non-rated Middle School-High School (6-12). USCF membership **required** to play in rated sections. USCF rated players must play in a USCF rated section.
- Entry Fee:** \$20 if pre-registered. \$30 for late and on-site registration.
- Registration:** There is a hard registration cap of 300 players restricted by the venue. Register online at georgiachess.org. Mailed registration - send check to GCA P.O. Box 2584, Suwanee, GA 30024. Mailed and online registrations **MUST** be received by Friday, January 13, 2012 to avoid late registration fee. Registration of any kind will not be allowed once registration cap has been reached; fee will be refunded if registration cap is in effect.
- Rounds:** 10am – 11:30am – 1pm – 2:30pm – 4pm. Awards ceremony occurs ASAP after round 5.
- Byes:** Max. two half-point byes allowed. Must request byes when registering.
- Prizes:** USCF rated sections: trophies to top 10 individuals and top 3 teams each section (except K-1). Non-rated sections: USCF memberships to all who score 3.5 or better. All sections: participation medals to all players. One year GCA Memberships will be awarded to first, second, and third places in each section.
- Please note:** Sets and Boards are provided. Please bring clocks. Pairing will begin **promptly** at 9:30am! Any registration issues outstanding after 9:30am will likely force late entry; player may not start play until second round. Please arrive early to deal with any suspected registration issues!
- Special Activities:** Charitable & educational activities between rounds to honor the memory of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. are being planned.
