

GCA By-Laws Proposal 2, Revision 2

Title: Establishment of Webmaster as an appointed GCA Board member

WHEREAS: the GCA values the relationship of a Webmaster who is closely associated with Board activities,

AND WHEREAS: the GCA recognizes that the Webmaster should have a distinct voice on the Executive Board,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the GCA establish the Webmaster position as an appointed Board position with the following changes to the By-Laws:

In 4.1 Membership:

Update to the current member total from “seven (7),”

Add “webmaster,” after “secretary,” (if magazine editor has been added, add “webmaster” after “magazine editor”).

In 4.2 Tenure:

Add “The webmaster is appointed by the Board for a one-year term.” after “1st vice president and 1st member at large.”

If Revision 1 is approved, *add* “the webmaster” after “The magazine editor”.

in 4.11 Quorum:

Change from “one half” to “four (4)”

In Officers and Agents:

Change “(items 5.10 through 5.16 are appointed officers)” to “(Items 5.10 through 5.11 are appointed officers who are members of the Executive Board)”

Renumber the existing items 5.11 to 5.12, 5.12 to 5.13, and so on, through 5.19.

Add 5.11 – *Webmaster*. The Webmaster shall be responsible for maintaining and editing the material for the official organization website.

Add after item 5.11 “(items 5.12 through 5.17 are appointed Board Members)”
